Arrival: Please arrive at least 15 minutes early. This is to ensure that the show will begin on time. We will be able to accommodate late seating as long as the performance is not sold out.

Public Transit Information:

Directions from the Market-Frankford Line

- Approximately a 10 minute walk to FringeArts. Get off at the 2nd St. stop. Head North on 2nd St. towards Church St. Turn right at Race St. and walk towards the waterfront. FringeArts will be on your right at the corner of Race St. and Columbus Blvd. For connections to the Market-Frankford Line, take trains headed towards Frankford Transportation Center and exit at 2nd St. stop.

Directions from the Broad Street Line

- Change to Market-Frankford Line at City Hall.

Directions from the Regional Rail Lines

- Change to Market-Frankford Line at 30th St. Station, 15th St., or 11th St. stops.

Directions from the Trolley Lines

- Change to Market-Frankford Line at 30th St. Station, 15th St., or 13th St. stops.

Parking Information:

- There is no onsite parking at FringeArts. The closest parking is located at [231 N. 2nd St.](#) (between Race St. and Vine St.) There is a parking fee: \$9 on weekdays and \$11 on weekends. This lot is a 4 minute walk to FringeArts.
- Limited, timed street parking is available along Columbus Blvd. and most streets in Old City.
- The parking lot adjacent to FringeArts is exclusively for the Holiday Inn and is unavailable to FringeArts visitors.

COVID Policy:

- Masks are optional for this performance.
- If you are feeling sick, we ask that you please wear a mask for the duration of time you are in the building.

- Performers will be unmasked during the performance.

About the Show:

- 10 years ago, we dared ourselves to create a show lasting 24 years. Every 2-3 years the company makes a new installment of *The Sincerity Project* in response to the shifts in our lives and in the world.
- This particular performance's themes center around parenting and community. The show is not geared for young children, though they are welcome. Please note that if you are attending this show with a child, there is a section where anyone under age 13 will be invited to an adjacent space to play games and have snacks while adult themes are discussed onstage. - The performance is approximately 75 minutes long with no intermission.
- A major component of this performance is the ability for the audience to write letters to themselves.
 - After the show, we encourage everyone to visit The Letters Station and write a letter to your future self. We will hold onto it for you until the next time you attend *The Sincerity Project*.
 - If we are holding a letter for you already from a previous installment, your letter will be available at The Letters Station.
- We welcome you to stick around and chat with the cast and team after the performance.

Accessibility:

- Performances are held indoors, and some are in the evening.
- Several of the streets surrounding FringeArts in Olde City are made of cobblestone.
- Complimentary companion seats are available to patrons who require a paid Personal Care Attendant (PCA). Please contact FringeArts Patron Services directly to reserve a PCA ticket, by email (PatronServices@FringeArts.com) or by phone (215-413-1318).
- FringeArts is equipped with a wheelchair accessible ramp entrance as well as an elevator. 20 wheelchair and companion seats are available in the theater's standard layout. Please speak to the Front of House manager upon arrival for assistance.
- Limited wheelchair accessible parking is available. Please contact FringeArts Patron Services to reserve accessible parking ahead of time.
- Service animals are welcome.
- The restrooms in the theater have wheelchair-accessible stalls, though the restroom doors are not automated. Restrooms are gender neutral.
- Sound Sensitivities: You may hear the sounds of loud cars and traffic, chatting, and applauding. There will be an opening musical act who will be playing music when audiences enter the theater.
